Primary & General Elections Important Election Dates for 2018

- Jul. 22:** Deadline for voter registration to vote in the August 21 Primary.
- Aug. 6:** Early, absentee in-person, special needs, and electronic submission voting begins
- Aug. 11:** Deadline for absentee ballot applications requesting by-mail ballots to be received
- Aug. 20:** Deadline for absentee ballot applications requesting electronic transmission ballots to be received
- Aug. 21:** **PRIMARY ELECTION DAY - Absentee by-mail ballots must be postmarked on or before this date, and electronic transmission ballots must be received by 8 p.m. AST**
- Oct. 7:** Last day to update voter registration or to register to vote in the general election
- Oct. 22:** Early, absentee in-person, special needs, and electronic submission voting begins
- Oct. 27:** Deadline for absentee ballot applications requesting by-mail ballots to be received
- Nov. 5:** Deadline for absentee ballot applications requesting electronic transmission ballots to be received
- Nov 6:** **GENERAL ELECTION DAY - Absentee by-mail ballots must be postmarked on or before this date, and electronic transmission ballots must be received by 8 p.m. AST**
